Responses were received from 89% of Members and 100% of employed staff.

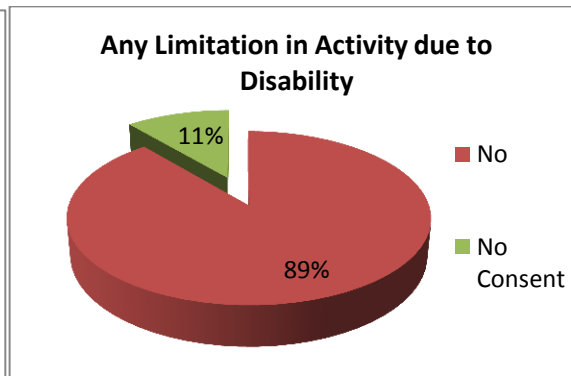
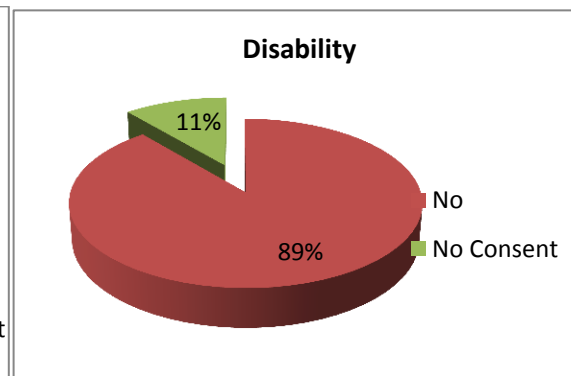
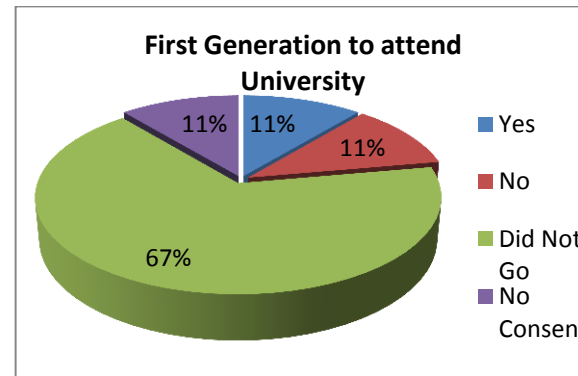
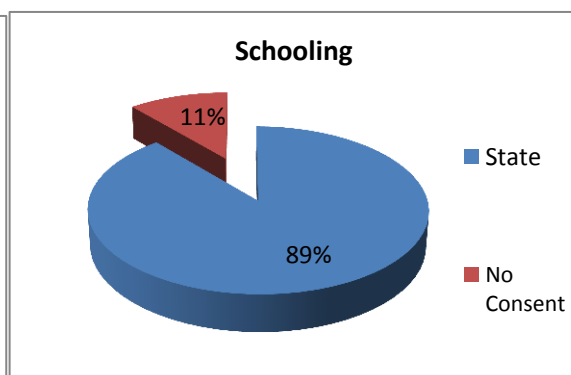
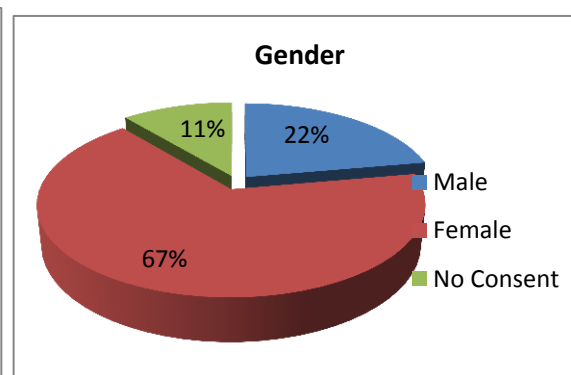
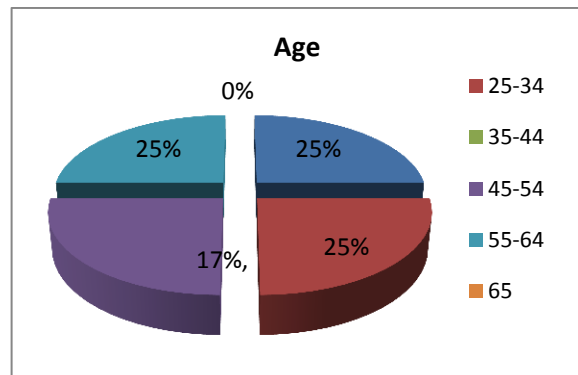
