Diversity Data for Spire Barristers

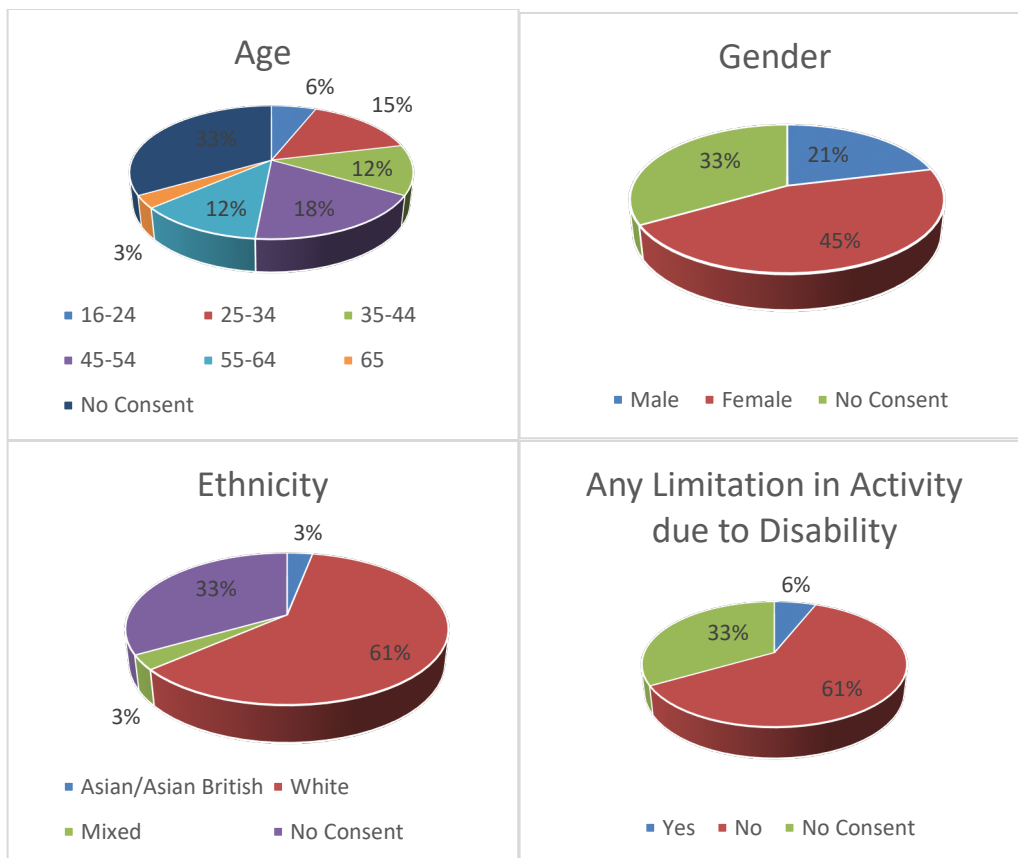

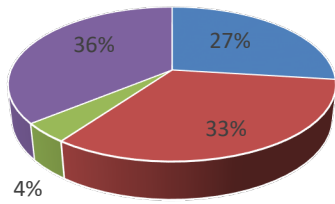
Responses were received from 73% of Members and 100% of employed staff.

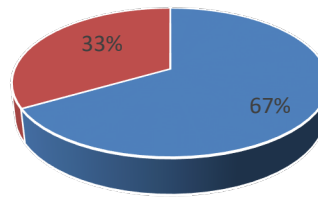

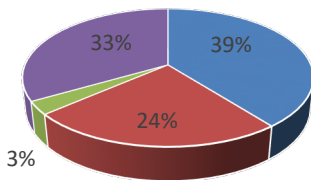

Sexual Orientation



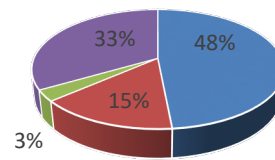

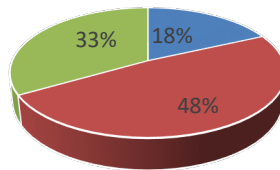

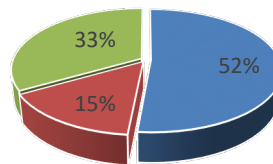

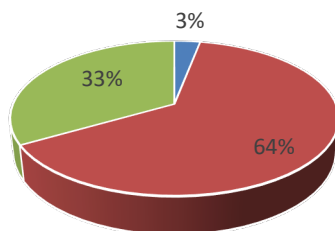

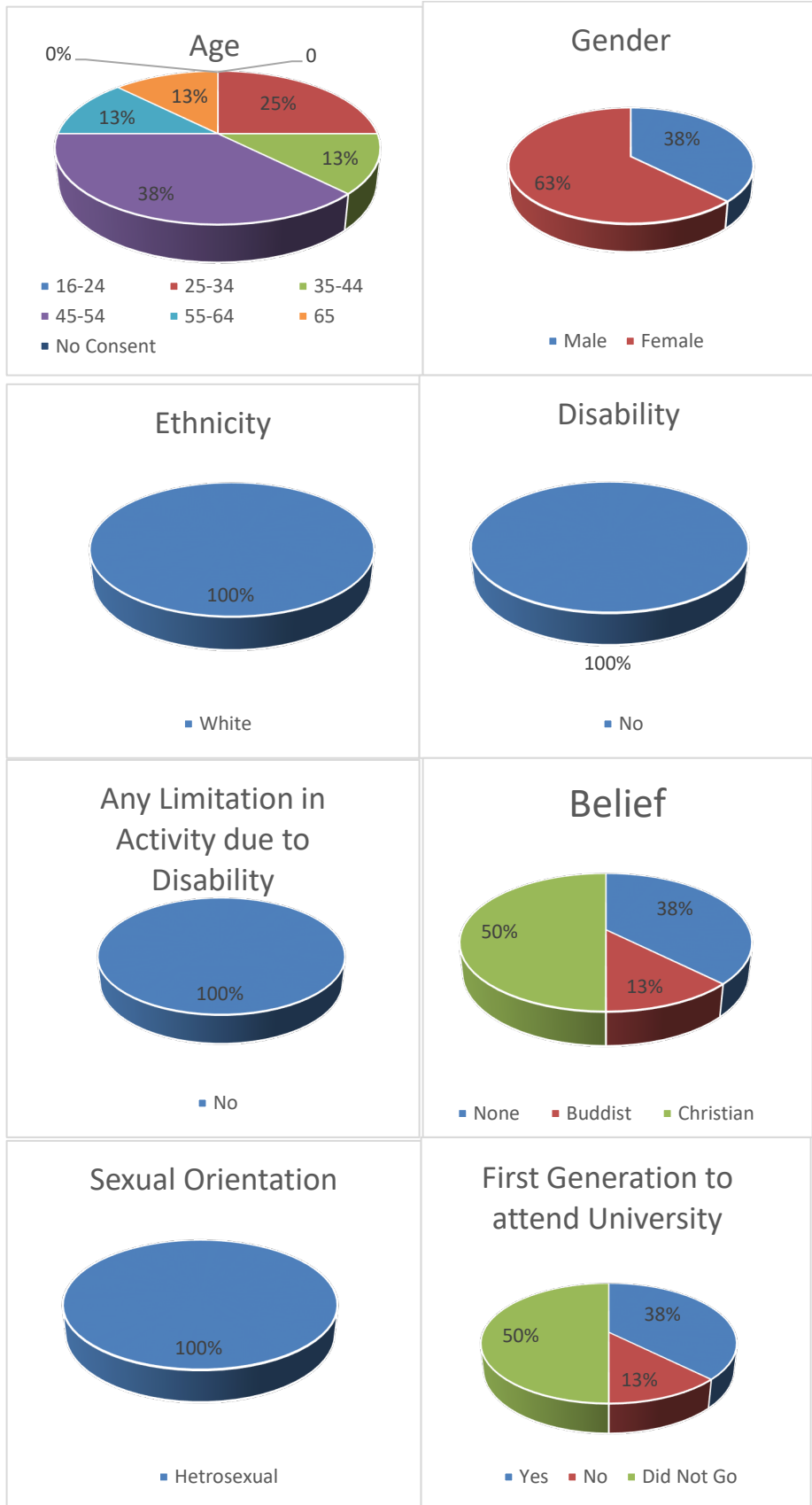

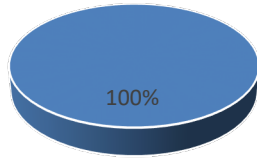

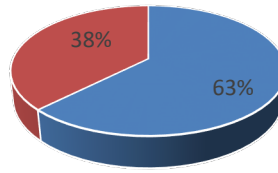

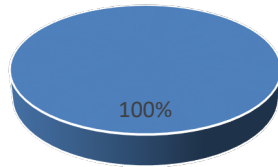
